Serving the youth at my church, I found myself looking forward so much to work every day—to leading Bible study and building community, to teaching and preaching, to raising up youth and young adult leaders within the church and empowering Sunday school teachers. I even enjoyed the administrative tasks. Eventually, I was asked to serve as youth director.

As many people around me began affirming my call to ministry, I also began facing roadblocks as a non-ordained and non-seminary-trained youth director. I chose to come to Columbia because this seminary is committed to preparing pastors, both inside and outside the classroom. Like the youth I served in my church, the faculty and staff on this campus have diverse opinions and come from a variety of ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds. We are continually engaged in a conversation about what it means to be a diverse community of faith. Wrestling with these questions here is preparing me to go back into the diverse and dynamic community of faith that is the Church of Jesus Christ.
