### John Gaden Drama Studio

Cranbrook boys are passionate about drama, their teachers are expert and inventive and Old Cranbrookians make significant contributions to Australian theatre and film. To cater for demand for more performance spaces – particularly for student directed productions – we are converting a large Bishop Building room into an adaptable drama studio. It will be named in honour of 1999 Cranbrookian of the Year, John Gaden, AM, one of Australia's most distinguished theatre practitioners.

John Gaden regularly gives his time to our boys, offering insights into their texts, providing valuable links with Sydney's theatrical world and helping actors prepare for roles in School and National Youth Shakespeare productions each year.

Our Annual Giving goal is to develop the John Gaden Drama Studio to professional performance level.


### Chapel Sanctuary

As an Anglican School, Cranbrook values the spiritual dimension in our boys' lives, whatever their faith.
